# The Castle of Shkodra

ili Kam

One of the well-known monuments in Albania and the Balkan Peninsula for its two sieges of the XVth century, is the castle of Shkodra. It is situated on a hill between the Buna, Drint and

Kiri Rivers and the Pasha Hill and Mebishedra field.
This castle was first used by the Illyrians who built the basis
on which the medieval castle lature on developed as it is nowaloss. Its situation proves that the builders had carefully chosen
the place, just as they usually did when constructing their small
the place, just as they usually did when constructing their small
powers, in strategie and overdeoxing points of important passage

areas, either land or water routes.

Traces of Illyrian construction are conspicuous at the entrance to the castle, between the first and the second gates as well as at the axis from the second and such both of them on the land.

Facts tell us that the well is built in the last libyrian period, before the Roman invasion began. A store wall without meeting, its outer side overeed with certib being quite evident and which forms a buse distributed to its north-eastern side that is no rist less nature defended part, is attributed to the Illyrians. The present form of the castle is no beinger Illyrians. The shape of the castle is almost oval and it is divided into three yards encircled with high walls. There are four fortified deffensive towers as well as a wide

Besides the main gate there were also underground roads which helped the people to get out of the castle and communicate with people of it.
