## On the demonstrations on this year's May Day

Despite the government's attempt to hinder the May Day protests, despite the traffic ban measures, which were still in effect, despite the slanders about "irresponsibility" of the protesters, despite the spread of fear among the people and the possibility of police intervention, concentrations and demonstrations did take place across the country today.
